From its beginning in 1979, the Postal Labor Unions Summer School has focused intently on the specific needs of union members in the U.S. Postal Service. A special strength of the summer school is its consistent ability to develop instructors who have come up through the union ranks. All have extensive experience in the union and most have been students of the summer school, making them uniquely qualified to understand the issues that face the stewards and officers who now are their students.

The heart of the curriculum is the grievance process, with the essential goal to foster skills and viewpoints that support the union and the labor movement. Although workshops are built around the steward's role, PLUSS also makes room for concerns and events that affect the labor movement broadly.



Each day begins with an assembly that supplements classroom learning, with subjects selected to meet the needs of the broadest range of participants. Students help design the agenda by choosing from a menu of assembly topics - or proposing a topic that meets their own unique needs and interests during the registration process.
